

WHAT TO BRING TO NORTH MARKET

What is already there?

- Twin Bed (standard)
- Chest of drawers
- Built in closet
- Drawing table with drawers and chair
- Eat in kitchen with counter & stools or kitchen table with four chairs
- Sectional Sofa
- Coffee table
- Floor lamp
- WIFI
- Basic Cable Ready
- Telephone with local calling

What to bring:

- Linens (towels, standard twin sheets, blanket, bedspread, pillows, mattress pad)
- Lamp for Bedroom
- Hangers
- Bathroom items (toiletries, rugs)
- Laundry bag, detergent, and quarters
- Shower Curtain
- Kitchen items (pots/pans, dishes, cutlery, glasses, can opener, toaster & coffee maker,)
- waste basket, trash bags
- Food items
- Television/Cable Cord
- Power strips, computer chargers & Extension cords
- Alarm clock
- Cleaning supplies
- Paper supplies (toilet paper, napkins, tissues)
- Basic tools
- Flash light
- Box cutter for unpacking
- Cell phone and charger
- Light bulbs
- Scissors
- Tape

What NOT to Bring

- Drum sets or other loud instruments (large amps)
- Grills
- Large speakers
- Pets of **any** kind
- Excessive amounts of belongings
- Alcohol/Drugs/Weapons (this includes empty alcohol bottles, paraphernalia, knives, decorative/historical swords, pellet guns, etc.)
- Air conditioners
- Waterbeds
- Pools or lawn decorations
- Candles/incense

**These items are in addition to clothes and any school supplies.*

PLEASE NOTE: The housing units have limited space therefore, it is important to be conservative with the amount of items you bring. Keep this in mind when you are planning for “what to bring”. All of the kitchens come with a refrigerator, stove, dishwasher, & microwave oven.
