STREET CLEANING NOTICE

This is a reminder that City crews clean and enforce street cleaning year round. Parking restrictions are clearly marked on signs posted in each block of the City.

Please be advised that street-cleaners can operate in the rain and when some snow and ice may be present on the street and curb area, so vehicles must be moved to avoid receiving a ticket.

In addition, the removal of leaves often requires more than one pass by the sweeper crews. Do not assume that once the sweeper has passed that it is okay to re-park on your street. Leaf removal may require more than one pass down your street.

The only times when street cleaning and enforcement will not occur is when high priority safety issues like salting and snow removal would prevent our crews from cleaning the streets on a given day.

SNOW EMERGENCY

Declaration of a Snow Emergency allows the Department of Public Works and the Police Bureau to restore a reasonable flow of traffic in the City as quickly and effectively as possible.

During Snow Emergencies, the City advises the public through local media and the City web site. Cars parked along snow emergency routes must be moved within one hour of the declaration of a Snow Emergency.

Failure to remove a vehicle from a Snow Emergency Route can result in a \$30 parking ticket or towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense.
