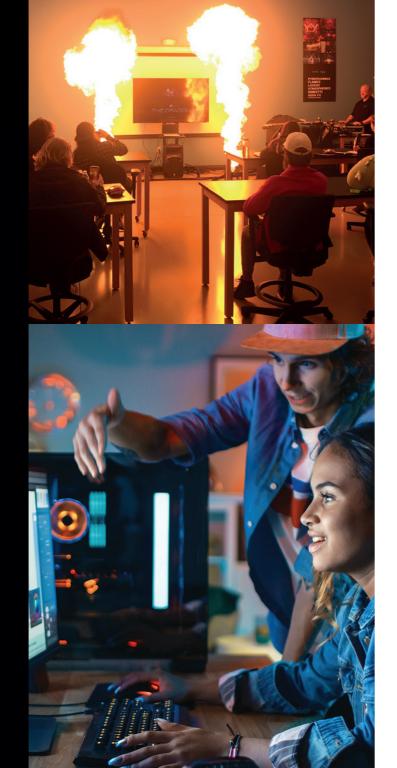
Founded by 7 local artists in 1982, Pennsylvania College of Art & Design was created to meet the need and feed the dreams of future artists and designers.

Why Live Experience Design @ PCA&D?

The BFA in Live Experience Design at PCA&D strikes a balance between theory and practice, preparing you to be a creative, contemplative problem-solver and experience designer. Through teamwork and mentorship, you'll acquire firsthand experience, knowledge of the industry, and concrete skills you can carry with you into a wide range of professional practices after graduation.

For instance, you'll learn to enhance and expand audience experiences in Extended Reality (XR) and virtual production through professional training at the Academy of Live Technology spaces and stages located in the vibrant arts district of Lancaster City, Pennsylvania, and on the world-famous Rock Lititz campus.

And you can gain experience in specialized fields, like building virtual worlds with gaming platforms like Unreal Engine, experimenting with immersive technology such as VR and motion tracking, and creating interactive visual experiences with projection mapping and LED walls to amaze audiences.

OUR FACULTY

The College works in partnership with world-renowned professionals from international corporate and industry studios like Backstage Academy in the UK and Rock Lititz in the US to ensure cutting-edge instruction in tomorrow's technologies.

Your instructors are experienced working professionals at the top of their fields with strong ties to resources and opportunities in this exciting global industry. They assign competitive, real-world projects to enhance your portfolio with professional work before you graduate.

Our faculty, and their vast experience with everything from bespoke events to mammoth productions around the world, are what sets our program apart. Simply stated, you will study with the best.

OUR PROGRAM

The BFA in Live Experience Design is separated into two concentrations: Live Performance and Curated Experiences. Beginning in your junior year, you will craft a tailored course of study that aligns with your specific area of emphasis.

The Live Performance concentration focuses on the acquisition of skills necessary for creating environments for a variety of live performances and entertainment (such as stage shows; live music, theater, dance; television, film, and online entertainment, etc.), advanced scenography, sculpture/3D design, lighting design, and animation.

The Curated Experiences concentration emphasizes the acquisition of skills necessary for creating curated and immersive experiences (museum/gallery exhibits; education or healthcare environments; themed restaurant/hotel spaces; immersive art installations, etc.), such as lighting design, soundscapes, interior design, video production, and immersive media.

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

A degree in live technology prepares graduates to play a critical role in staging live events experiences in everything from corporate presentations to world-class performances.

Students majoring in Live Experience Design at PCA&D will graduate with a broad set of critical thinking, designing, and making skills.

In this four-year progressive program with the world's leading instructors, you'll learn the technical, design, and management areas of live events including production, lighting design and technology, live sound, live visuals, and the business of the live events sector in areas as diverse as theater, live music, concert touring, and corporate and sporting events.

Through a core curriculum in art/design history, theory, and technology, and anchored in hands-on studio work and practical field experience in partnership with the industry's top studios, you will gain a foundational knowledge of the concepts and skills used in experience design.



In your junior and senior years, you'll select a concentration in live performance or curated experiences. You'll gain professional experience at an internship site and complete a year-long senior studio, culminating in the creation of an interactive experiential environment as part of the senior thesis show.

Where are they now?

Pennsylvania College of Art & Design is partnering with Backstage Academy for a globally recognized program with graduates who now work on major productions. Most recently, graduates from the UK-based Academy have worked on shows from the West End stage to Hollywood film production to the global tours of such musical giants as Beyonce & Jay-Z.

Graduates have created experiences around the world, including working with Warner Brothers to create content for the upcoming Lord of the Rings series, leading the installation of a visual exhibition at the Dubai 2020 Expo, and stage managing a world tour for Ed Sheeran.
