2. Upload a 250–500 word personal statement about why you love making art and what you hope to learn at PCA&D.

Request for official transcript(s) to be sent to PCA&D Admissions at **admissions@pcad.edu** by your school guidance or registrar's office.

PCA&D does not consider SAT / ACT scores during the application review process. Recommendation letters are optional.



APPLICATION DEADLINES

Our College operates on a rolling admission basis. Applications are reviewed throughout the calendar year on an individual basis. The priority application deadline is **March 1** for fall applicants and **December 1** for spring applicants.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

SELECT

Your portfolio should consist of **8-10 recent, original artworks** that demonstrate your abilities in a range of artistic media. Include at least **2 pieces from direct observation.** Select artwork that showcases your problem-solving and decision-making skills, and the originality of your ideas.

PREP

Develop an order for your artwork that makes sense and has a meaningful flow. Good lighting and clarity are very important when photographing your artwork. Keep time-based selections to 3 minutes or less.





SUBMIT

Go to **pcad.edu/submit-portfolio** to create your portfolio account and upload your portfolio pieces. Don't forget to press submit!
