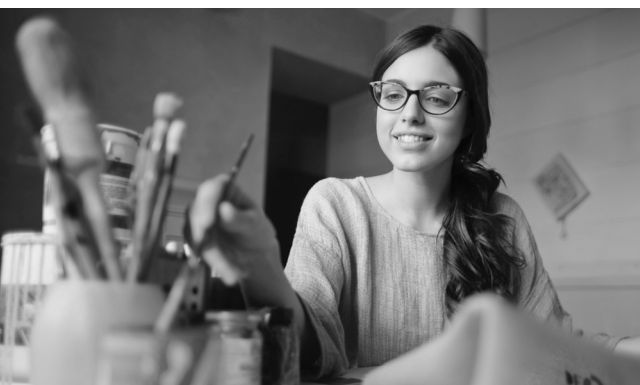
## **The Center for Creative Exploration at PCA&D**
