Starting this fall, every PCA&D student will be enrolled in a new healthcare program that enables you to access quality healthcare services throughout your college experience.

located near PCA&D on Franklin & Marshall's campus and operated by Penn Medicine/Lancaster General Health. Here you will have access to a wide range of healthcare services, including primary care, preventative care, specialist referrals, immunizations, medication support, and other necessary medical services.

This new program will ensure you have timely treatment for medical issues without resorting to costly and inconvenient emergency or urgent care center visits. You will

have access to routine office visits, laboratory procedures, immunization administration, and minor in-office procedures, among other services. The Health & Wellness fee of \$160 per semester will be billed to your student account. This program provides you with comprehensive healthcare options while utilizing your own insurance. Additionally, because of students' desire for greater access to personal

counselors, beginning this fall, all PCA&D students will have access to unlimited teletherapy provided by Virtual Care Group (VCG). VCG connects students to a diverse pool of licensed mental health providers for unlimited scheduled counseling sessions as well as offering a 24/7/365 mental health call option. Students will also have access to sessions with Certified Life Coaches, nutritionists, financial planners, and other

experts. All of these services are confidential and will be offered at no cost to students. Student Affairs staff will provide introductory training on using VCG's app and access process during Welcome Week. These initiatives are a testament to our commitment to your wellbeing and we hope you take full advantage of these new resources. If you have any further questions or need additional information, please do not hesitate to reach out to Student Life. You will be receiving information from our Student Affairs staff and Lancaster General Health over the next few weeks.




