

Share the opportunity

PCA&D offers those who paused their college journey the opportunity to complete a degree or certificate within one year through the financial and academic support of the <u>ACHIEVE program</u>. A collaborative project led by the Lancaster County Workforce Development Board, ACHIEVE allows Pennsylvania residents the opportunity to complete an associate degree, bachelor's degree, or undergraduate certificate on a full scholarship. The scholarship includes tuition and a variety of resources that will help students complete a degree.

To be eligible, students must: be a Pennsylvania resident; be able to finish the degree or certification by June 30, 2024; have exited college after January 1, 2021; had a 2.0 GPA (or higher) upon exit.
