You must purchase a blank poster (pay from \$0 to \$20) to participate in the Print Crawl, and each poster comes with a map to follow to the eight participating print shops. Buy your poster at the link below, and pick it up at the registration table in Heritage Square, corner of King and Queen streets next to the Visitors Center. Food trucks will be stationed along the route for refreshments, and several downtown locations also will be open with discounts. <u>Seasons Taproom</u>, in Downtown Lancaster, is looking for fall-themed art to hang in their shop. Submissions are due by Sunday, Sept. 10 at 11:50 pm in order to qualify for being juried. You will be notified by email Tuesday, Sept. 12, of accepted work, and art will be displayed in Seasons Taproom from Sept. 18 through Nov. 6.

Rules: You may submit up to three artworks; artwork should be no longer than 24 inches on its longest side; the artwork should be ready to hang; themes of nature, seasons, landscapes, and still life works are preferred.

Juried 'quick draw' event at Lititz Italian festival

Artists of all experience levels are invited to Lititz Springs Park north of Lancaster on Saturday, Sept. 16, for a quick-draw event, "All'Aperto," to capture the "Spirit of L'Italia." Artists are free to use any 2-dimensional medium to depict their chosen subjects, and may submit up to three works to the jury. Artists are expected to work by hand, without digital means. Registration is free, and cash prizes of up to \$250 will be awarded. The event is part of the L'Italia Festival of Lititz that day.
