#### Important information: 2023-24 Student Council

Student Council elections for 2023-24 are coming up — here's what you need to know:

PCA&D Student Council represents the interests of the PCA&D student body. As a member of Student Council, you would help to plan community events; create rules, norms, and traditions that strengthen our community; and represent and advocate on behalf of student interests. Please see the <u>PCA&D Student Council Constitution</u> as well, which discusses the role of Student Council more thoroughly.

This September is the beginning of a new election cycle for Executive Members of the Student Council. The positions up for election include:

- \* Student Council President (responsible for overseeing Student Council)
- \* Student Council Vice President (responsible for liaising with student body)
- \* Student Council Treasurer (responsible for overseeing budgets & resources)
- \* Student Council Secretary (responsible for communications and record-keeping)

<u>If you are interested in running for a Student Council position:</u> please use <u>THIS LINK</u> - <u>DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY</u> to officially record your intent to run for office. You will also need to select AT LEAST ONE of our campaign-running workshops to attend during the lunch hour (11:30 am to 12:30 pm) today, Monday, Sept. 18, Wednesday the 20th, or Friday the 22nd. If you are interested in running for office but cannot attend any of these meetings, please email <u>ccrossett@pcad.edu</u> to make alternate arrangements ASAP.

These workshops will help you develop your strategy and launch your campaign. Campaigning for Executive Member positions will occur Sept. 25-29, with voting for Student Council positions over the weekend of Sept. 29-Oct. 2. The winners of the Student Council elections will be officially announced at the Student Council Meeting on Friday, Oct. 6 during the lunch hour (11:30 am to 12:30 pm) in the Co-Lab. <u>11:30 am on Fridays in the Co-Lab will be the standard meeting time for Student Council this year.</u> All Student Council meetings are open to the PCA&D community.

# Arte de La Borinqueña programming highlighted at PCA&D-York location

Pennsylvania College of Art & Design is excited to announce that portions of the landmark exhibition *Arte de La Borinqueña* will be showcased at



PCA&D-York through Dec.10. The exhibition will be open to the public during programming that includes a talk with PCA&D faculty member **Mike Hawthorne**, an award-winning graphic novelist and one of the many artists associated with the La <u>Borinqueña</u> series. Some highlights include an <u>Arte de La Borinqueña Reception, a</u> familyfriendly First Friday event that will take place at PCA&D-York, 133 S. Duke St., York, from 5-8 pm on Friday, Oct. 6.

Through the medium of a serialized comic, artist **Edgardo Miranda-Rodriguez** has amplified and highlighted the importance of telling stories about

Puerto Rico's history, exploring present-day social and environmental issues, and celebrating the diversity of the Puerto Rican diaspora. La Borinqueña launched in 2016 under Miranda-Rodriguez's studio, <u>Somos Arte</u>, where he serves as Creative Director and is a noted philanthropist. The story came at a pivotal moment for Latinx and Hispanic communities as political tension and a series of natural disasters rocked the Caribbean.

La Borinqueña has become a real-life superhero with a suite of graphic novels, a special anthology, *Ricanstruction*, <u>benefitting grassroots organizations on the islands</u> <u>of Puerto Rico post-Hurricane Maria</u>, partnerships with DC Comics, Chocolate Cortés, <u>NRDC</u>, and more.
