Pennsylvania College of Art & Design is excited to announce that portions of the landmark exhibition *Arte de La Borinqueña* will be showcased at PCA&D-York through Dec.10. The exhibition will be open to the public during programming that includes a talk with PCA&D faculty member **Mike Hawthorne**, an award-winning graphic novelist and one of the many artists associated with the <u>La</u> <u>Borinqueña</u> series. <u>pcad.edu/event-calendar.</u> Some highlights include an <u>Arte de La Borinqueña</u> <u>Reception, a family-friendly First Friday event that will take place at PCA&D-York, 133</u> S. Duke St., York, from 5-8 pm on Friday, Oct. 6.

Through the medium of a serialized comic, artist **Edgardo Miranda-Rodriguez** has amplified and highlighted the importance of telling stories about Puerto Rico's history, exploring present-day social and environmental issues, and celebrating the diversity of the Puerto Rican diaspora. La Borinqueña launched in 2016 under Miranda-Rodriguez's studio, <u>Somos Arte</u>, where he serves as Creative Director and is a noted philanthropist. The story came at a pivotal moment for Latinx and Hispanic communities as political tension and a series of natural disasters rocked the Caribbean.

La Borinqueña has become a real-life superhero with a suite of graphic novels, a special anthology, *Ricanstruction*, <u>benefitting grassroots organizations on the islands</u> <u>of Puerto Rico post-Hurricane Maria</u>, partnerships with DC Comics, Chocolate Cortés, <u>NRDC</u>, and more.

College receives \$500,000 grant for LiveX major

PCA&D has received a \$500,000 grant from. The Steinman Foundation to assist with the development of our new Live Experience Design & Production major and our partnership with Rock Lititz and UKbased Academy of Live Technology (ALT). As part of the grant, **Dr. Jason Hartz**, the faculty leader of the Institute that guides the partnership, will be known as the Steinman Dean, Institute for Leadership, Creative Entrepreneurship, and Innovation.

President Michael Molla said that the grant will be a major contribution to ensuring that the Institute and the partnership can begin its work on a strong financial foundation. "With this grant, The Steinman Foundation ensures that PCA&D and our partners will have resources to secure the best possible faculty and administrative leadership in place for our students."

Hartz, who has more than two decades of experience in the classroom and in higher education administration and leadership, has served PCA&D as Chief of Staff and has been instrumental in developing the LiveX curriculum and forging the partnership with ALT. "I'm thrilled to take on this new role at PCA&D and move our ALT at Rock Lititz partnership to the next level," Hartz said.
