Lancaster City seeking illustrator, graphic designer for cartoon character development

If you are an illustrator or graphic designer or know of an artist who is interested in a commission for the development of a cartoon character and coloring sheets, the City of Lancaster has issued a Request for Qualifications for illustrators and graphic designers to develop a cartoon character, Rosie the Fish, for the City's River Connections project, an initiative to cultivate a greater sense of stewardship and community around the Conestoga River and advocate for its care and repair.

The artist will develop a Rosie the Fish cartoon character and color sheets for web and print. Rosie the Fish is an animated ambassador to educate the public, specifically school-aged residents, about the river and the work done through the River Connections project. See attached RFQ. This opportunity is open to all professional artists and teams, 18 years and older. **The submission deadline is June 24.** The City anticipates an artist will be selected by July 19. The selected artist will have a budget of \$3,000 to complete the work.
