## Mandatory! Sign your SFRA form!

Have you completed your Student Financial Responsibility Agreement (SFRA) form yet? This agreement ensures all students understand the College's billing processes and procedures, and **MUST** be signed and submitted by every student each semester.

The SFRA contains information related to payment of tuition and fees, delinquent accounts, financial aid, communication methods, and other important topics. You can access the SFRA in two ways: either from MyPCAD or your Student Portal. Use the following instructions:

### MyPCAD

1. Log into MyPCAD account at [ss.pcad.edu/](https://ss.pcad.edu/) (If you are unable to log in or are locked out, please contact the IT Department at [IT@pcad.edu](mailto:IT@pcad.edu) or by phone at 800-689-0379 extension 1004.)
2. Click the "Finances" tab.
3. Select the "Student Financial Responsibility Agreement" item.
4. Carefully read the agreement.
5. Sign the "Student Financial Responsibility Agreement" electronically and then click the Save button.
6. Finally, click the Next button in the upper right and then Finish.
7. You will receive an email at the email address you entered at sign-in. Please print and keep the email for your records.

### Student Portal

1. Navigate to the PCA&D Student portal at [pcad.edu/student-portal](https://pcad.edu/student-portal)
2. Select the "Student Financial Responsibility Agreement" tile.
3. Carefully read the agreement.
4. Sign the "Student Financial Responsibility Agreement" electronically and then click the Save button.
5. Finally, click the Next button in the upper right and then Finish.
6. You will receive an email at the email address you entered at sign-in. Please print and keep the email for your records.

You can access a copy of the agreement after you submit it.

## Main Gallery exhibition: *Unearthing Solitude*

PCA&D's Main Gallery welcomes **Callie Morton '22**, Fine Art, in an exhibition of her work completed during her time as the 2024-2025 Fine Art Artist in Residence. *Unearthing Solitude* will be celebrated with an Opening Reception this week on First Friday, Sept. 5, from 5-9 pm. The work, Morton writes in an artist statement, "bridges together a journey of new life. Exploring themes of abandonment and identity through painting and printmaking, the work grew to tell my story of recovery. This body of work began in the midst of my addiction and through time found its conclusion in my life in recovery. Figures carry expressions and colors that explore playfulness and melancholy. As the work progressed, so did the willingness to play and experiment in connection with artistic principles of color, shape, and composition..." *Unearthing Solitude* runs in the Gallery through Oct. 10.
