Pieces should express the spirit of democracy and enthusiasm for civic engagement through voting; as the organization is non-partisan, pieces should not express support or opposition to political parties and should not reference specific candidate names. *The Art of the Vote* is designed to showcase 2D pieces; addition of mixed media may be added to the primary piece, and the full piece should not exceed 18" by 24". **The first 25 submissions will be accepted for display.** All artwork should be securely wired and ready to hang via an art hanging system.
