Looking for a space that allows you to experiment or workshop your ideas? The College's PCA&D-York space is being reimagined as a creative pop-up program called the PCA&D Work/Space. There, artists and creatives can submit an application/proposal to use the space for an experimental action, event, or creative idea in two-week increments for a small fee of \$50.

The PCA&D Work/Space program will be creatively flexible, with anticipated possible uses being group reading or writing sessions, studio space for testing out larger works, a space to view an evolving body of work at one time, or for temporary installations, etc. The goal is to promote curiosity, prototyping, and exploration of new concepts within the York community.
