Faculty Life grants are open for Spring 2025

Two types of Faculty LIfe grants have now been opened for Spring 2025 applications. The two types are explained below, and **the application deadline for both grants is Monday, March 31.** All PCA&D faculty are eligible to apply for these grants: adjunct, part-time, full-time, and CCE faculty.

Educators Professional Development Grant: Link to guidelines, more information, and to apply <u>here</u>. Examples of this include, but are not limited to, curriculum development, pedagogy, conference attendance/participation, workshops, and anything relating to educational skill development.

Research & Practice Professional Development Grant: Link to guidelines, more information, and to apply <u>here</u>. Examples of professional development supported by this grant include, but are not limited to, conference attendance, conference participation, research, travel, residency, and publishing.

Those receiving professional development funds will report back and present on the experience and outcomes of their faculty development activities. The scope and nature of this presentation will reflect the activity funded.


It's tax season: Finding your W-2 form

Faculty Biennial featured in the Main Gallery

Be sure to stop by the Main Gallery to check out the 2025 PCA&D Faculty Biennial. Featuring the work of 36 of the College's faculty, the Biennial is a traditional celebration of the artistic practices and talents of instructors in our PCA&D community.

Now in the CORE Gallery: BLAC exhibition

Where is Everyone?, an exhibition by members of PCA&D's Black Led Artist Coalition, or BLAC, is now on display in the Mezzanine-level CORE Gallery. The theme of this show showcases the artist's personality or representation of themselves through art -- hence, showcasing where they are as an individual.

Judges needed for MADCom creative contest

Help inspire and support the next generation of design and media professionals by helping to judge MADCom, the Media and Design Competition. This virtual judging opportunity takes place during the week of March 31-April 4, and is part of the Center for Creative Exploration's partnership with our Intermediate Unit (Lancaster-Lebanon IU13). Each year, IU13's Educational Technology team hosts the regional MADCom, open to middle and high school students, in six categories: 2D Design, Animation, Digital Movie, Logo and Graphic Design, Programming, and Web Page Design. Winners in each category advance to the state competition, held in May at Elizabethtown College.

Here's how the process works:

- Project Submission: Students will submit their projects to an online dashboard by March 25
- Virtual Judging: Judging will take place virtually during the week of March 31–April
- Student Showcase (Optional to Attend): On April 8, from 9–11 am, they are
 hosting a Student Showcase at the IU Training & Conference Center (located
 at 1020 New Holland Ave.). Judges are welcome to attend to interact with
 students and view their projects up close.
