The City of Lancaster has opened applications for the Neighborhood Art Project, a new initiative designed to encourage public art and creative placemaking. Proposals from local artists across all mediums are sought for this year-long residency program to foster civic dialogue, elevate neighborhood concerns, and highlight cultural or historical stories

that have been overlooked. Explore the connections between art and civic government through National Endowment for the Arts support. Rock Lititz seeks production intern

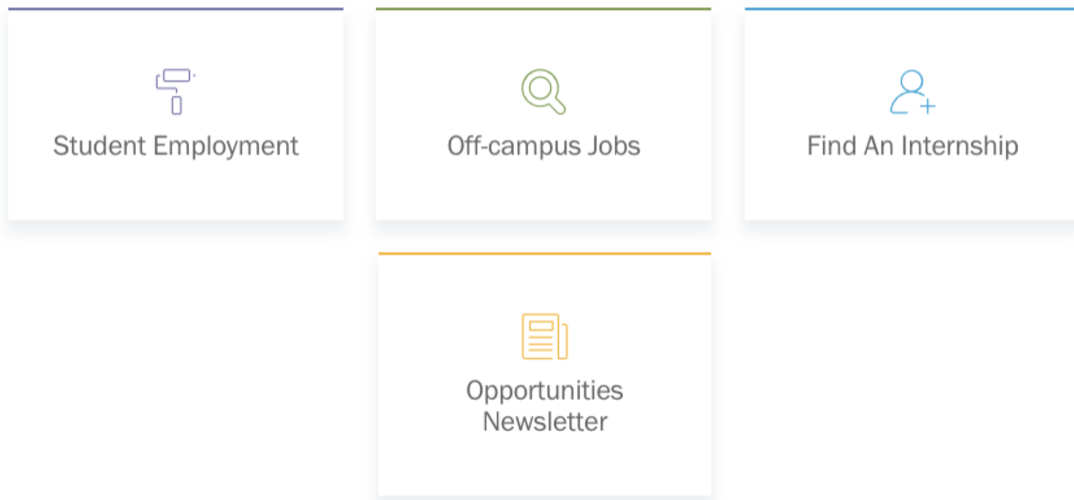
