Call for Entries: *Art of the State 2025* open now

Are you a Pennsylvania resident? If so, you're eligible to submit to this year's Call for Art for *Art of the State*, the 58th annual juried exhibition boasting a tradition of presenting highly creative art by Pennsylvanians, chosen by a distinguished panel of jurors.

The call for entry for *Art of the State 2025* is open to Pennsylvania residents who are at least 18. Artists may submit work in one or more of five categories: painting, work on paper, sculpture, craft, and photography/digital media. Entries must be submitted online, and there is a \$30 entry fee.

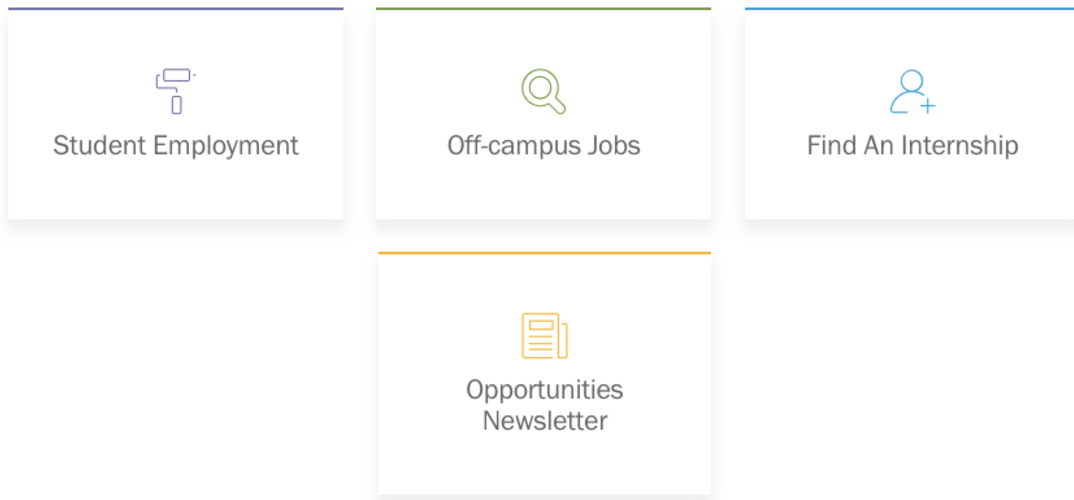
