Artisan Wreath Market in Lancaster

An Artisan Wreath Market is being held by Lancaster City Alliance, Gallery Grow, Fig Industries, and Lancaster Art Vault, on Black Friday and Small Business Saturday, Nov. 29-30, from 10 am to 5 pm, outside Lancaster Art Vault, 100 N. Queen St. Here's how it works:

Purchase an undecorated wreath for \$10 at Gallery Grow, 150 N. Prince St., through tomorrow, Nov. 16, from 10 am to 5 pm. Decorate the wreath, and return to Gallery Grow on Nov. 21-23. Label the wreath with the artist's name and email.

Artist-decorated wreaths will sell for \$95. **Proceeds from the sale of those wreaths will go directly to the artist, minus 15% which will be donated to the Lancaster County Homelessness Coalition.** Unsold wreaths may be picked up at Gallery Grow beginning the week of Dec. 1. Payments to artists for sold wreaths will be distributed by Dec. 16. More information [can be found here](#).

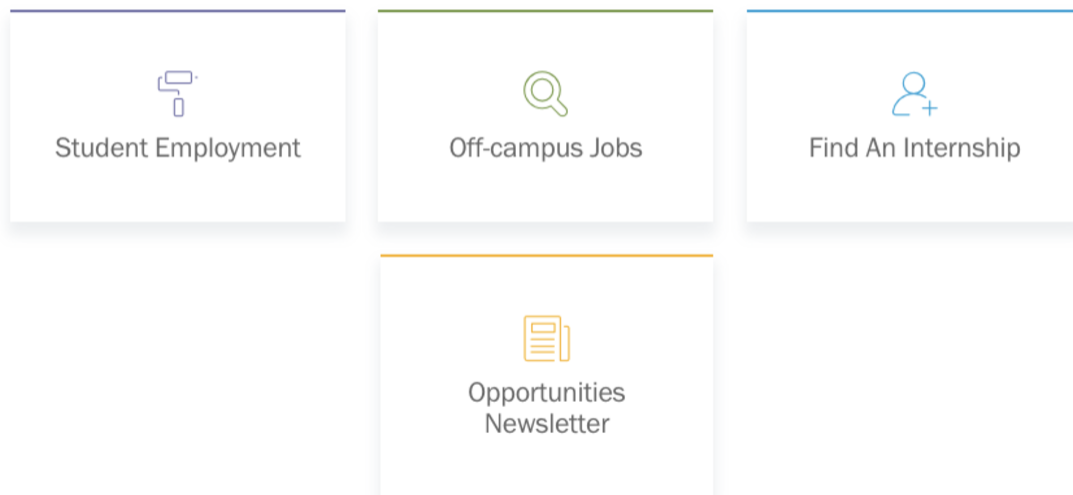
