Artists who may not possess the full range of skills or experience required to fulfill every aspect of the project are strongly encouraged to form teams with other experienced artists. A total budget of \$90,000 has been allocated for this project. This must cover all artist fee(s), insurance, drawings, renderings, models, materials, fabrication, installation, lighting, equipment, travel, artist-led community engagement, and other project-related expenses.
