Nationwide search for mural artists

NOW Art is seeking artists nationwide to design original murals for community-focused programs. These public-facing projects are in partnership with different clients, and each should be delivered as digital compositions or scanned high-res, traditionally created artwork files. Approved artwork will be printed on vinyl, enlarged, and adhered in site-specific locations. Artists should: be skilled in Photoshop, Illustrator, Procreate, or other

software, or be able to generate scanned digital files of works that are color-corrected and clean to enlarge at scale; be able to produce high-res files at a minimum of 500-720 dpi. 
