Dr. Andrew Barnes takes the helm as PCA&D President

Pennsylvania College of Art & Design welcomes **Dr. Andrew W. Barnes**, who officially began his new role as President of the College on Jan. 13. In interviews with both local and regional media outlets, Dr. Barnes outlined plans for not only maintaining and growing its local impact in the local arts community, but also increasing its profile on the regional and national levels as well. In <u>an interview with</u>

LNP/LancasterOnline, Dr. Barnes said he sees untapped potential in the College, which has nearly doubled its student body numbers from 2015.

"PCA&D did something really smart," Barnes told LNP, "they didn't overgrow ... There's tons of room for growth ... so we can grow smartly and I think we will grow over the next five to seven years."

Dr. Barnes confirms plans to utilize the former Chameleon

The College has announced plans to renovate the former Chameleon Club in Lancaster, which it purchased in 2021, into studio spaces and a location for growing a creative artist accelerator. Under current plans, recent graduates would be able to receive a year's worth of business and creative mentorship in the former nightclub building, further preparing them for careers in the creative industry such as opening a brick-and-mortar location. ABC27 reports President Barnes says the space should be up and running within the next couple years. "If you

talk to any business person out there, it doesn't matter what the business is, they say one thing, they say the same thing -- 'we need people who can think outside the box, who can think creatively.' That's what art and design does."
