





- Justin Phillips, Assistant Dean of Academic Affairs, held his first solo exhibition in Europe, at Galerie Abstract Project in Paris. *Introductions, Knowing, Select Works 2020-2025* ran from June 16 through June 28, with an opening reception June 18. The works are a formalist exploration into the juxtaposition of processes that merge from saturation and folding of paper and intuitive mark making. These various methods work together to create subtle works that reflect moments of time captured in a multitude of ways.
