### A message from Bursar Eliud Diaz:

If you had issues entering or exiting the Water Street Parking Garage on March 4, 5, or 6, please email him at <u>bursar@pcad.edu</u> so he can inform the Lancaster Parking Authority, which owns and operates the garage. If you have a parking pass and incurred fees during those dates or any time since receiving your parking pass, please follow these steps:

- 1. Collect all tickets from the garage.
- 2. Scan or take a picture of each ticket.
- 3. If you incurred out-of-pocket expenses, include a copy of the charges from your bank or credit card statement.
- 4. Briefly describe your experience in your email.
- 5. Include your mailing address for potential refunds.

**Please note:** Although PCA&D partners with the parking authority to issue your student parking pass, the College is not responsible for reimbursing any fees resulting from operational issues with the garage.

We will work quickly to address any reimbursements with the Lancaster Parking Authority on behalf of all of our students.
