

### 2 scholarship sweepstakes open for students

The Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) is offering 12 \$2,500 PA Forward sweepstake scholarships to students who are Pennsylvania residents, and an additional 12 \$2,500 Keystone sweepstake scholarships to residents of Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Ohio, Virginia, and West Virginia. Participation in the PA Forward or Keystone loans is not required for scholarship consideration. These are no-essay-required scholarship sweeptstake entries. Winners will be announced in August and December.

### Class of 2025: email, Google Drive, Adobe info

Class of 2025 -- now that you're alumni, there are some important changes coming to your email, your Google Drive storage, and your Adobe Creative Cloud: **These changes will take place on July 1.** 

- Your PCA&D email address will be updated from "last name 4 digits" to a "first name, last name" format (for example, doe1811@pcad.edu to janedoe!@pcad.edu). This will also be your new email login for PCA&D!
- Your pcad.edu alumni account will remain active for another 2 years (730 days).
   After that, your account may be subject to deletion after 2 years (730 days) of inactivity.
- Your Google Drive storage quota will be reduced to 15 GB. Please check your Drive to ensure you don't have files larger than that limit as they will be deleted on July 1.
- Adobe Creative Cloud access will be disabled. However, you can migrate your
  Adobe content from your school account to a personal one using the following
  link: <a href="https://graduation/adobe.com/">https://graduation/adobe.com/</a>. Please note that this must be done ASAP
  before losing access on July 1! Microsoft 365 access will remain active as long as
  your account stays actively in use.

### Registrar's message for returning students

A message from Registrar Hannah Warner for returning students:

The Self Service course registration portal is now closed. While you can't adjust your schedule online, you should still be able to see <u>live information about which classes are running in the fall and if seats are still available in each one ("register" tab, click "traditional courses", and then "section search").</u> From now until the end of the add/drop period next semester, schedule adjustments will be completed through the Registrar's Office. In the event you would like to change your schedule, you may <u>request a schedule change here</u>. By submitting requests through this link, the Registrar's Office can easily track everyone's requests and make notes for each entry we receive. If you need to, you may submit more than one. All changes are made on a first-come first-served basis. We will do our best to accommodate everyone's requests, based on your degree plans and course availability.

Additionally, there are several classes that have seats available that meet various degree requirements (humanities, general studio electives). There are also sections of the fall foundation level courses (art history, communications, and studio) if there is a course you need to retake next year. If you can't remember or are unsure if you need to retake a fall semester foundation course, you can review your grades in Self Service ("grades" tab, click "unofficial transcript") to see if there are any "F" grades.
