The Pennsylvania College of Art & Design is seeking an instructor for their professional development certificate course DES 151 Adobe Illustrator. This is a contracted position for the Center for Creative Exploration Fall 2025 (September-November) session. The course meets online once a week for 10 weeks from 6-9 pm.

- Additionally, the instructor will help students learn vocabulary, illustration tools, and output methods in Adobe Illustrator.

- Possess strong background in and proficiency of use of Adobe Illustrator.
- Understanding of fundamental image creation in Adobe Illustrator.

- Interpreting realism/representational work in vector form

- Students will complete projects that demonstrate proficiency in areas such as:
 - Understanding the pen tool and various techniques
 - Manipulating and creating compound shapes
 - Building form through color, gradients, blends etc.
 - Creating a realistic illustration combining all previously learned skills
- Students will complete the course with an understanding of how to save and export files for web versus print media
