The Pennsylvania College of Art & Design is seeking an instructor for their professional development certificate course DES 152 Adobe Photoshop. This is a contracted position for the Center for Creative Exploration. The course meets online once a week for 10 weeks from 6 - 9 pm.

 as a photographer is not required, students are expected to learn how to merge multiple
 images into one document (image compositing/merge), use basic photo editing tools
 like:
 - Levels
 - Brightness/Contrast
 - How to open and work with RAW files in Photoshop
 - How to resize and save images for printing or use on the web.
- Ability to develop and deliver content through virtual platforms (specifically Google Classroom) and attend additional online education training
- Strong administrative and organizational skills with consistent accuracy, follow-through, and timely completion of projects
- Teaching experience is preferred.
- Exemplary communication skills, ability to express ideas clearly and concisely both verbally and in writing, and a strong public speaker

CURRENT COURSE DESCRIPTION

"In this class, we will familiarize ourselves with the basic principles and possibilities available in Adobe Photoshop. Students can expect to develop an understanding of pixel-based imagery, resolution, color builds, interface tools and palettes, vocabulary, color correction and perfection, layers, layer masks, art brushes, animation, web graphics and output methods.."

CURRENT COURSE OUTCOMES

- Students will understand and demonstrate proficiency in foundational Photoshop tools (layer usage, brush usage, filters, text usage and manipulation, color usage and manipulation, resizing and saving files properly and more)
- Students will complete projects that demonstrate proficiency in areas such as:
 - o Photo manipulation
 - o Image montage
 - o Incorporation of text
 - o Drawing/Illustration
- Students will complete the course with an understanding of how to save and export files for web versus print media
