In 2026, RegenAll's Youth Climate Art Exhibition will be a pre-event component of **RegenAll's Annual Climate Summit**. Students from around the county will have the opportunity to express their vision of a thriving, resilient, and sustainable “**green future**” to promote creative and hopeful thinking for the next generation. We hope that their work will inspire decision-makers, lawmakers, and community members to see a better future for our shared environment.

The exhibition will be held **November 8 - 15 at Pennsylvania College of Art & Design's Welcome Center (241 N. Prince Street, Lancaster, PA)** with an opening reception on **Friday, November 13, 2026 from 5 - 7:30 pm.**

A slideshow of the artwork will be shown at RegenAll's Climate Summit at **Hoffer Farm (547 N Penryn Rd, Manheim, PA 17545)** on **Saturday, November 14, 2026.**

PROMPT: What does your idea of a green future look like?

<u>2-D Visual Art Guidelines</u>	<u>3-Dimensional Art Guidelines</u>
Students may submit 2-dimensional artworks. Please make sure the artwork is dry and ready to hang or tack and must be smaller than 2 feet long x 2 feet wide. Digital artwork submissions are also accepted this year and would be included in a digital slideshow. Files should be under 2MB.	Students can submit 3-dimensional artworks, which can be functional pieces, original inventions, or “outside the box!” The project must be transportable by car and must be smaller than 2 feet long x 2 feet wide x 2 feet deep.
Age groups for entry are: ● Pre-K - 2nd Grade ● 3rd - 5th Grade ● 6th - 8th Grade ● 9th - 12th Grade	Physical artworks can be created in partner workshops and daycamps or created at home and submitted in-person at Pennsylvania College of Art & Design, 204 N Prince Street, Lancaster, PA 17603. If submitting artwork directly to the college, please attach a completed entry form found on the next page OR digital submissions can be sent by email to ce@pcad.edu. Please be sure that a completed digital copy of the entry form is attached to your email.
